



COUPAR ANGUS Townscape Heritage Initiative

Application for a Conservation Training Grant

The Coupar Angus THI Executive Committee is responsible for the management and implementation of the Coupar Angus Townscape Heritage Initiative which involves proposals for the repair and improvement of identified properties within the Coupar Angus Conservation Area to help sustain the local economy and vitality of the town. The scheme is being supported by Communities Scotland, Coupar Angus Regeneration Trust, Heritage Lottery Fund, Historic Scotland, Perth & Kinross Council and Perth & Kinross Heritage Trust.

A grant of up to £200 or 50% (whichever is less) of the course cost and reasonable travel expenses are available to help defray the cost of attending approved conservation courses. To be eligible, the applicant must live or work within the Coupar Angus area. To be eligible, the application may be submitted by the trainee or the trainee's employer and must be approved by the THI before the course starts. Grants will be dispursed after the course, on presentation of evidence of the trainee successfully completing the course together with invoices for all sums claimed. The grants are limited at this stage to £200 per person, but may cover more than one course or application.

By accepting the grant, the trainee/applicant agrees to take part in any reasonable publicity of the THI.

The offer of a grant is made solely at the discretion of the THI and sums available for this scheme are limited.
